

RADIO AWARDS



Eighty-nine awards were presented during the Radio Awards ceremony held on 26 November in Parktown, Johannesburg. Christa Mostert was a finalist in the category Station Manager's Choice. This is awarded to the unsung heroes who work behind the scenes. Christa was chosen as the winner in this Category at the awards. Through Christa's perseverance and determination in marketing Maluti FM, the station survived a dark period in world history. Brenda Shepherd (Station Manager) said that this award is a huge honour for not only Maluti FM but for our community as well. Despite challenges, this award clearly confirms Maluti FM as the local community radio station to listen to. Maluti FM is proud to be part of the Dihlabeng community which the station serves. This was the 12th year that the Radio Awards honour outstanding achievements across campus, community, public broadcast service (PBS), commercial, podcast and internet radio, setting benchmarks for all stations and professionals to strive towards. The entries were adjudicated by a panel of 37 judges and reviewed by BDO SA, the official auditor of the Radio Awards. Entries for this year's awards were required to broadcast on FM or AM between 01 January 2021 and 31 March 2022.


